



5 Quick Tips to Kickstart Quality Improvement in Your Practice

Success in healthcare demands collaboration and shared vision among all members.



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Improving quality performance in healthcare does not always require large-scale change. Many successful improvement efforts begin with small, focused actions that help teams learn and adapt over time. The following five steps can help practices begin building a culture of continuous improvement.

Step 1: Define Clear Goals

Start by selecting one or two quality measures that matter most for your practice, such as blood pressure control or colorectal cancer screening. Clear goals help teams focus their efforts and make it easier to track improvement over time.

Step 2: Form a Quality Improvement Team

Create a small team that includes clinical staff, administrative support, and a physician or clinical champion. Regular short meetings or “huddles” help teams stay aligned, discuss progress, and identify opportunities for improvement.

Step 3: Use the PDSA Method

The Plan-Do-Study-Act (PDSA) cycle allows teams to test small changes before implementing them practice-wide.

Plan – Identify a small change you want to test

Do – Implement the change on a small scale

Study – Review the results and learn from the experience

Act – Adjust the approach and expand successful changes

Testing small improvements reduces risk and helps teams learn what works best.

Step 4: Leverage Data

Use EHR reports, health plan dashboards, or patient registries to monitor outcomes and identify care gaps. Data provides insight into where improvement is needed and helps practices track progress over time.

Step 5: Celebrate Wins and Sustain Momentum

Even small improvements deserve recognition. Sharing successes with staff helps maintain motivation and reinforces the importance of quality improvement across the organization.
